

TONY IMBURGIA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

MISSION: The Tony Imburgia Scholarship was established by the Knights of Columbus Council #4168 in memory of Tony and his commitment to helping others in our community of faith by assisting children of St. Francis Xavier in their efforts to gain a Catholic education at St. Francis Xavier School.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must be enrolled at St. Francis Xavier School for the current or subsequent school year. This scholarship is not based on the financial need of the applicant.

Applicants will be judged on:

1. Related student activity, volunteer experience of student and family participation at St. Francis Xavier School, Parish and Community
2. Essay content and quality of answers
3. Letter of reference

APPLICATIONS

Interested applicants must complete the Tony Imburgia Scholarship application form. The application form will be available on the St. Francis Xavier School website. Forms are available by calling St. Francis Xavier School at 330-725-3345 or the School Office. The deadline for submitting a completed application is the last Friday in April of the current year. Applicants will be notified and receive their award at the Awards Ceremony before the end of the current school year. The scholarship award will be deducted from the school year's tuition.

AWARDS

The Tony Imburgia Memorial Scholarship awards up to ten (10) scholarships each year. The scholarships for the 2024 - 2025 school year will be in the amount of \$500 each. The Tony Imburgia Memorial Scholarship Committee screens all applications for eligibility. St. Francis Xavier School administers the scholarships funds which are awarded. The decision of the Tony Imburgia Scholarship Committee is final.
